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FOREWORD

Best Time in Jiangsu

Jiangnan is famous for its scenic views since a long time ago. It is love at first sight with the spectacular view of its ancient cities. Jiangsu is a long-lost land of joy. It is a paradise on earth with its water village.

Jiangsu is a quaint beauty with historical significance during the Chu-Han era. Known for the Horse-training Terrace, the residence of the Overlord of Western Chu, the majestic Nanjing Foding Temple with an arch spreading over 200 meters in length at the Niushou Mountain, and Suzhou's largest classical garden, the Humble Administrator's Garden, which comprises multiple structures of traditional residences in the conventional Jiangnan. A walk through these ancient sites is like travelling back to a thousand years of time.

Ancient cities like Yangzhou, Zhenjiang, Huai'an, and others in the Jiangsu Province are considered prosperous places in Chinese history. They are also the heart of Huaiyang Cuisine, one of four renowned cuisines in China. The Qing Dynasty emperors, Kangxi and Qianlong, have high regards for the Huaiyang Cuisine, naming it the most delicious cuisine on Earth. Touted as the "mother of all operas", Kunqu Opera originated from Kunshan in Suzhou. Since hundreds of years ago, people love sipping Ah Po tea and having snacks while listening to the opera, amidst the serenity of the garden. Such a trend has evolved into a signature lifestyle in southern Jiangsu. Wuxi's Yantouzhu (Turtle Head Park) is the most beautiful corner of Taihu Lake, primed for its hills and waters where its uniquely scenic views of each of the four seasons attracted visits from poets and scholars in the past and now local and foreign tourists too. See flowers bloom amidst the thick mist in Yangzhou during the lunar month of March. Visit Huai'an for its lotus blooms at Jinhu Lake. Enjoy the cool autumn ambience in Nanjing Qixia Mountain. Yancheng is the best tour destination in winter to witness the red-crowned crane dancing in the sky - a mesmerizing romantic view set against the white backdrops of snow. Any season is perfect to enjoy in Jiangsu due to its flowers blooming in spring, sunny weather during the summer, red maple leaves in autumn, and snow falling in winter.

WHERE IS JIANGSU

Enjoy a peace of mind with a change in lifestyle and pace. Jiangsu is full of tourism resources and numerous historical sites. Majority of the tourism spots are located along the Yangtze River and the Grand Canal. Taihu and its seashores form a unique tourist destination based on its mountainous range and waters, providing the ambience of a peaceful, cozy and comfortable environment. Jiangsu has more than 10 ancient sites listed under the World Heritage List. The ancient buildings in Jiangnan are recollections of history at any given time.



Xuzhou is the birthplace of the Han Dynasty with over 6,000 years of civilization history and 2,600 years of history in the making of the city. It is a place which consists of a large number of cultural heritage, historical sites and profound historical value.



Suqian, touted as "the capital of Chinese Liquor", produces two of the famous types of liquor in China, namely Yanghe and Shuanggou. It is also the birthplace of the Western Chu Overlord, Xiang Yu, thus referred to as the "Heroic Capital".



Located at the intersection of Yangtze River and Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal, **Yangzhou** is a historical cultural city with 2,500 years of history. It is touted as the "First City of China's Canal", also named as the Moon City of China. Yangzhou spearheaded the application for the Grand Canal to be listed as a World Heritage. A total of six canals and 10 historical remains have since been listed as World Heritage Sites.

Huai'an is located in the intersection of ancient Huaihe River and the Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal, and it has the fourth largest freshwater lake in China-Hongze Lake-in the territory. The waterway of Huai'an in the Grand Canal is listed in the World Heritage Site. This city is the hometown of the Premier Zhou Enlai.



Nanjing, also known as Jinling, has a history dated more than 2,500 years ago and has accumulated 1,800 years of it as a capital city. For most of its history, Nanjing has been the political administration and cultural centre of southern China. It has been the capital for ten dynasties such as Wu, and Eastern Jin.

Zhenjiang, the land of abundance produce in Jiangnan, is home to many places of interests such as, Sanshan, Maoshan, Xijindu, and Nanshan. With the Yangtze River and the Grand Canal intersecting here, it is also called "The Best Landscape under Heaven".

With its flat terrain and richness in raw materials, **Yancheng** earns the name "A Land of Abundance." It is where Jiangsu's longest coastal line, largest beach, and the national nature reserves for two precious species: the elk and red-crowned crane, reside.



Taizhou



In the past, **Taizhou** is a famous historical and cultural city of China, with more than 2,100 years of history. Notable talents in the cultural and arts history like Wang Gen, Shi Nai'an, Zheng Bangqiao, and Mei Lanfang all originated from Taizhou.



Lianyungang is a city where mountains, sea, harbours and other cities meet. It is the meeting point of the "One Belt, One Road" initiative, and also where famous classical novels originate like *Journey to the West*, and *Jing Hua Yuan (Flowers in the Mirror)*.



Nantong is one of the first 14 coastal cities in China opened to the outside world. With seven "firsts" to its name, including first teacher's academy, and first private museum, amongst others, it's no wonder it's called the First City of Modern China.



Suzhou has four distinct seasons and plenty of rainfall. It produces silkworm, mulberry, Taihu Whitebait, Yangcheng hairy crabs, and many more. Suzhou Gardens are the most well-known private gardens in China and have been added to the World Heritage List.



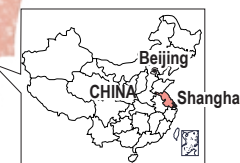
Wuxi, with Yangtze River on its north and Taihu on its south, lies in the plains of the Yangtze River Delta and is called the "Pearl of Taihu". Wuxi has breath-taking views and is rich in cultural heritage. It is the root of the Wu-Culture and the birth place of 3,000 years of civilization history.

Chu and Han Xuzhou is the hometown of Liu Bang and former capital of Xiang Yu. Xuzhou is given prominence as the birthplace of the glorious Han civilization with more than 400 years of prosperity involving the East and West Han Dynasty. The tombs, stone relief, and Terracotta Warriors of Han Culture are collectively named the "Three Gems of Han Dynasty". More than 200 gravestones were carved out of rocks and magnificently built with excellent craftsmanship. Thousands of pieces of stone relief with portraits depicting the grandeur of the Han-Era, and the sight of more than 4,000 terracotta army in stand-by position, leads one to travel back in time to the glorious era of Han. The legacy in these well-crafted relics exquisitely present the extravagant of the Chu-Han culture. Ximatai (Horse-training Terrace) or better known as Playhouse Gate has witnessed the parade of warriors and war-horses since Xiang Yu's time more than two thousand years ago. A walk into Xuzhou can be likened to a walk into a dazzling cultural treasure trove.

Leisure Landscape Xuzhou's magnificent view combines boldness and gracefulness. The seventy-two peaks and seven lakes in the Xuzhou precinct are scenic spots one cannot afford to miss. The Yunlong Lake Scenic Area is classified as a rate 5A tourism spot with breathtaking scenery of lakes and mountains. Mount Yunlong is stretched over nine peaks like a dragon hidden in lush forests. The Yellow River runs through the city. The Beijing-Hangzhou Grand Canal which is listed on the World Heritage Site runs along the river. Pan'an Lake, Dalong Lake, Xuanshui Lake, Mount Luliang, Mount Maling and many more, are some of the natural scenes that contribute to the splendid view. Thus, the famous Poet, Su-Dongpo exclaimed: "Watch spring sprawl beneath Yunlong Mountain, the sunset view of the Fang-He Pavillion, the almond bloom stretch as far as 30 miles, my beloved groom rides like the wind".

Lion Hill

Liu Wu, the third king of Chu State of Western Han Dynasty, was laid to rest here 2,100 years ago. The hills which stood at 54.3 meters above sea level was almost hollowed out in order to build his mausoleum. You may also visit the Han Terracotta Warrior Museum, the Underwater Terracotta Warrior Museum, and the Han Stone Relief Gallery in the Han Cultural Scenic Area.

Yunlong Mountain

Yunlong Mountain which consists of nine peaks and is always covered in fog, is how it derives its name. Although it stood a mere 142 meters above sea level, there are many monuments here from the era of the Northern Wei Dynasty to the Qing Dynasty. There is an observatory tower on the mountain top overlooking Yunlong Lake and Xuzhou City area. There is also the Yunlongshan Temple Fest held annually on the lunar calendar of February 19.

Hometown of Xiang Yu, Crab Festival, City of Liquor

Crab Festival ─ Suqian, known as the "home of poplar trees" and "home of aquatic products", is rich in cotton, silkworm cocoons, whitebait, freshwater prawns, and crabs. At the annual Sihong Crab Festival, crabs too have caught up with the change of time. They are now labelled with a QR code. A scan reveals details such as the supplier's name and the environment which they have grown up in. During the festival, there are tournaments such as "Know Your Crab Fairy", "The King and Queen of Crab", and also a marathon in the wetlands. Two of the eight famous brands of liquor in China are from Suqian, namely Yanghe and Shuanggou. There is a famous saying for tourists who enjoy both delicacies – it is the utmost pleasure of "holding a wine glass with the right hand, and a crab-claw with the left".

Emperor Qianlong visited five times ─ Suqian is a modern city with four distinct seasons and pleasant weather. The water system is established with wide roads and urban greens are seen everywhere. The people here are friendly and passionate, leading a serene lifestyle. As the hometown to Xiang Yu, the great overlord of Western Chu, the segment of Grand Canal at Suqian is on the World Heritage List. Despite its long history, Suqian is the youngest prefecture city in the Jiangsu Province. Of the six visits that Emperor Qianlong made to Jiangnan, he stayed at his auxiliary palace "Qianlong Xing Gong" here for five times.

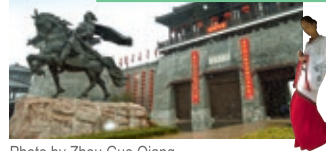

Xiang Yu's ancestral home, which features the overlord's family tradition, showcases the characteristics of a civilian residence during the Han Dynasty as well as the architecture of a palace, focusing on the building, weaponry, costumes, machinery and daily necessities of the Western Chu culture. Legend has it that there is still an ancient Japonica tree planted by Xiang Yu personally - a magnificent plant with a peculiar look that lives on after 2,000 years.

The Wetland of Hongze



The wetland, with the size of 350,000 acres, is the largest freshwater wetland reserve in Jiangsu, home to some 194 types of rare bird species such as the Great Bustard, Oriental white stork, black stork, red-crowned crane, Reed Parrotbill, and many more. More than 60 types of facilities have been built here including a multimedia exhibition centre, museum, aquarium, fishing centre, water tennis court, beach volleyball court, golf-driving range and a water sports centre.

Located next to the beautiful Luoma Lake, it covers an area approximately 12.7 square kilometers with more than 100 types of trees grown and is 98% covered in forest. The density of an ion can be as high as 20,000 per cubic centimeter - truly a natural oxygen bank. Main attractions include Na-Tian, Lake of Mirror, natural forest hill, Xiangsi Lake, Qing-cui Lake, Plum-flower Garden, and others. Visit these places to view seas of flowers bloom during spring, lotus during summer, maple during autumn, and snow melting at the Plum-Flower village during winter. More than 10 types of flowers race against each other to blossom from April to June and between September to November each year. Special events are held at the scenic spots during extended holidays such as the Labour Day break and National Day Golden Week.

Yellow Dog Pork Heads

While there is no direct connection of any sort with dogs, the name came from the founder of the shop, Huang De, who was given the nickname "little yellow dog" during the Emperor Qianlong era. The pork is braised to redness in colour, is rich in aroma and pure in taste. Emperor Qianlong tasted it once and was full of praises for it. The shop owner then poured the remaining soup left by Emperor Qianlong into his cooking pot, which was then passed down to the next generations and this dish thus became known as the "Qianlong soup".

Capital of Canals in China, Premier Zhou Enlai's hometown, Wu Cheng'en's hometown, Home ground of the Huaiyang Cuisine

Capital of Canals in China Huai'an has more than 2,200 years of history. Touted as "a piece of land floating above water", Hongze Lake is a mist-covered lake whereas Baima Lake is abundant in aquatic produce. With the Grand Canal winding through, the ancient water of Huai River flow to the east. A city born owing to its surrounding waters, Huai'an is named alongside Yangzhou, Suzhou and Hangzhou as the four metropolitans of the Grand Canal during the heyday of the Ming-Qing Dynasties.

Origins of outstanding people There are numerous famous figures from Huai'an like the great militant Han Xin, Han Literature Master Mei Cheng and his son Mei Gao, Heroine Liang Hongyu, author of "Journey to the West" Wu Cheng'en, the national hero Guan Tianpei, Beijing Opera masters Wang Yaoqing and Zhou Xinfang, and the greatest man of the era, founding premier Zhou Enlai.

Journey to the West With thousands of years in the cultivation of culture, Huai'an people are ambitious and idealistic. The establishment of tourist spots based on the literature *Journey to the West* went on to be highly promoted. A pilgrimage site was even built for *Journey to the West* with an oriental theme-park concept, offering the classics a new lease of life.

Wenlou Steamed Dumplings



A local delicacy that has a thin skin wrap and the fillings are made with 12 types of mixed ingredients such as pork skin, minced chicken meat, crab roe, dried shrimp, bamboo shoots, spices, Shaoxing wine, and more. KEY WORD

Red-crowned Crane, Elk, Sea Salt, Shi Nai'an

The city surrounded by salt Yancheng gained its name due to the salt-boiling farm and river since 119 BC. Every street name and area here consist of the Chinese character 'salt' (pinyin: yan). For example: Yandu Park and Yandu Area. With more than 2,000 years in the history of sea salt boiling to its name, various salt related buildings or agencies including the District office of Salt-Agency, Salt Ancestral Hall, Salt Merchant Association, Salt Museum of China, and many more are established.

Habitat for the red-crowned crane and Elk Yancheng has a nice coastline, having the largest beach with the widest coverage of sea, which attracts the red-crowned crane and elk to reside here. Every year during winter, more than 1,200 red-crowned cranes gathered in Yancheng, making it the largest crane gathering ground during winter in the world. It is also an important breeding ground for the endangered species – the Black-billed Gull.

Inspiration for "Water Margin" Shi Nai'an, the author of *Water Margin*, followed Zhang Shicheng, who was the leader of the peasant revolts towards the end of the Yuan Dynasty. He lived in Baijuchang, Yancheng for a while. Some scholars believed that the 108 heroes of Mount Liangshan are in fact the mimicry of generals in the revolt army. Thus, it is highly possible that this is the source of inspiration for the life in Mount Liangshan as told in the *Water Margin*.

More than 800 birds of the red-crowned cranes fly here each year to evade winter. There are also many other protected species that can be found here, such as the river deer, and it is an important shelter for rare migrating birds.

Dongtai Fish Noodle Soup

One of the Jiangsu cuisines, the main ingredients are the noodles and thick soup base which drops like beads and yet refreshing in taste. Besides tasting good, it also caters for one's wellness by warming the stomach and nourishing one's spleen as well as acting as a tonic to the digestive system. As wild carp, eel bones, pork bones and other raw materials are used to boil the soup, it is high in protein, rich in calcium and amino acids, yet low in fat.

Jianhu Taro Ball Soup

Jianhu Taro Ball soup has been around for more than a hundred years. Using taro powder of excellent grade as the main ingredient, sugar, mashed dates, sesame powder, and lard or vegetarian oil are added and mixed in, which is then wrapped in pastes made from osmanthus, and then boiled in water till it's cooked. The pellet-shaped light purple balls are soft, plump, and sweet without greasiness with the fragrance of the osmanthus. It is a famous treat among locals and foreigners.

Historical and Cultural City Yangzhou is an important part of the Jiangsu-Yangtze River Economic Belt. It is also one of the first few cities chosen to be recognized as a Historical and Cultural City of China. The history of Yangzhou City dated back to the year 486 BC. The Yangzhou stretch of the ancient canal is the oldest part of the Grand Canal. Together with the stretch in Gaoyou, both are listed as World Heritage Sites.

Misty Flowers in April Yangzhou offers the most beautiful flower blooms amidst mists during the third month of the lunar calendar, which is the month of April (of the Gregorian calendar). This is the best time to visit Yangzhou. Rain and mists are the norm during spring in the south of Yangtze River. The fluffy catkins from the willow trees fly all over the sky amidst the spring breeze giving a snowy look on the banks of the Slender West Lake.

Gaoyou double-yolk duck eggs Gaoyou Lake, the third largest lake in Jiangsu Province, produces plentiful Gaoyou duck (one of China's famous three ducks), mass production of large eggs, large proportion of yolks, fine and rich duck oil, and it is famous for producing double yolk duck eggs and it is ranked as the second among the "100 flavors worth tasting worldwide". The duck culture that are reflected at China Duck Cultural Museum in Gaoyou is amazing and educational.

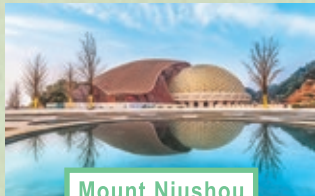
China's Four Ancient Capitals ─ Nanjing is one of four ancient capitals of China. It is also an important birthplace of Chinese civilization. Ancient human activities are recorded as early as 1 to 1.2 million years ago with history of civilization dated for more than 7,000 years. On 472 BC, King Yue ordered Fanli to build a fortress. Nanjing has been a capital with 2,500 years of history. It is known as an ancient capital that has served six dynasties and is the metropolitan of 10 dynasties.

Nanjing Yunjin ─ is highly regarded as one of the "Four Famous Brocade of China", and was even primed to be the top of the four. Nanjing Yunjin has been around near to a thousand years and considered as the intangible cultural heritage of the world that is likened to an inch of gold for an inch of Yunjin. Its splendor of colour and beauty that mimics the gorgeous clouds earned itself the beautiful name. It also retains the traditional way of weaving using wooden jacquard machine.

Traditional Architecture ─ The Confucius Temple is located by the banks of the Qinhuai River, where the culture of Nanjing began and it seems to be the crown of Qinhuai. Talents of all walks and merchants alike were gathered here. Famous literati includes Zhou Yu, Du Mu, Li Bai, and Wu Jingzi who wrote impressive literature work while they were here. Ever since the Ming Dynasty Emperor Zhu Yuanzhang declared Nanjing as a capital, many cultural relics of the Ming Dynasty are discovered here.

Mount Niushou Scenic Area

Da Bao'en Temple Heritage Park

Da Bao'en Temple Heritage Park is located just outside the Nanjing Zhonghua Gate, with Qinhuai River on its north and Yuhuatai to its south, connecting 1865 Park Area on the east and Yuhua Road on the west. The whole park covers approximately 200 acres of land. Changganli is a Buddhism sanctuary in Jiangnan, touted as the Buddha Lane. Since the temple was built in the early Eastern Wu Dynasty, Changgan Temple, which emerged during the Jin Dynasty, was famous for worshipping relics of Buddha. It was not long after the temple was rebuilt in the early Song Dynasty that it was renamed to Tianxi Temple, where it continued with the worships of various relics.

Changzhou Cuisine The cuisines are a combination of the best from the south and north, as well as unique features of the east and west. The cuisines combine the flavors of the Jiangnan's essence in culture. One would not think of going home when on a gourmet tour to Changzhou. The fresh and delicious puffer fish, saury and anchovy, the delicate and delicious white fish, white shrimp and whitebait from Taihu, the thick gravy of fish head from Tianmu Lake cooked in casserole pot, the meaty greasy crab from Changdang Lake, the thin and refreshing mini crab bun, the fragrant and soft sesame cake, as well as traditional soft snacks such as silver silk noodles are some of the delicacies that made people remarked: "if you did not savour Changzhou dishes, you have not visited Jiangnan."

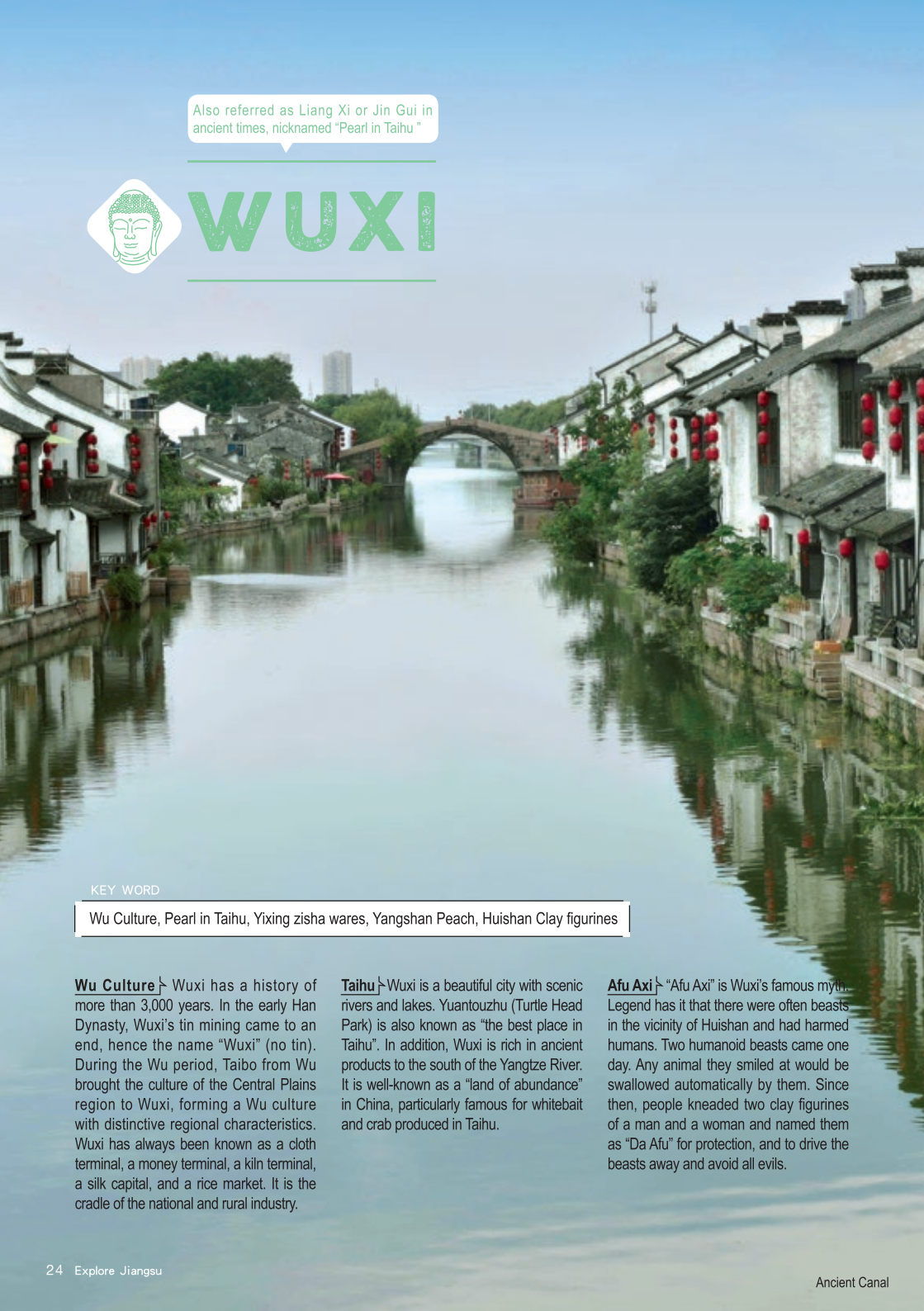

Wu Culture Wuxi has a history of more than 3,000 years. In the early Han Dynasty, Wuxi's tin mining came to an end, hence the name "Wuxi" (no tin). During the Wu period, Taibo from Wu brought the culture of the Central Plains region to Wuxi, forming a Wu culture with distinctive regional characteristics. Wuxi has always been known as a cloth terminal, a money terminal, a kiln terminal, a silk capital, and a rice market. It is the cradle of the national and rural industry.

Taihu Wuxi is a beautiful city with scenic rivers and lakes. Yuantouzhu (Turtle Head Park) is also known as "the best place in Taihu". In addition, Wuxi is rich in ancient products to the south of the Yangtze River. It is well-known as a "land of abundance" in China, particularly famous for whitebait and crab produced in Taihu.

Afu Axi "Afu Axi" is Wuxi's famous myth. Legend has it that there were often beasts in the vicinity of Huishan and had harmed humans. Two humanoid beasts came one day. Any animal they smiled at would be swallowed automatically by them. Since then, people kneaded two clay figurines of a man and a woman and named them as "Da Afu" for protection, and to drive the beasts away and avoid all evils.

Turtle Head Park

It is a peninsula in the northern part of the Taihu. There is a large garden and a cruise to explore Xian Dao, an island on Taihu. Cherries on the island blossom in spring. There are also Taoist temples with statues as well as Buddha statues. A climb to the top of the hill presents a panoramic view of the surroundings. Wanlang Bridge is a good place to watch the sunset over Taihu.

"Suzhou Gardens" is the collective name for parks in Suzhou, where mainly are private gardens. Suzhou is well-preserved as a city and there are more than 60 classical gardens open to the public, of which 9 of them are the Humble Administrator's Garden, Lingering Garden, Lion Grove Garden (Shizilin), Master of the Nets Garden, Canglang Pavilion, Ouyuan Garden, Huanxiu Villa, Yipu, and Tuisi Garden. These classical gardens have been included in the "World Heritage List". Humble Administrator's Garden has its unique historical position and value in the history of gardening. Its superb artistic approach on mountain and river has a strong traditional Chinese ideology and cultural connotation.

Jinji Lake is located in the China-Singapore Suzhou Industrial Park. The area is slightly larger than the West Lake in Hangzhou. Compared to the ancient classical city, the high-rise buildings and modern designs show the other side of Suzhou. It is a national AAAAA-class tourist scenic spot, a national business tourism demonstration zone, and China's largest urban lake park. It is a symbol of Suzhou's "new heaven on earth" in the 21st century. Jinji Lake is a picture of modern water paradise. The area is divided into five main functions: cultural exhibition zone, modern shopping zone, leisure and gourmet zone, city tour district and central water spot.

Mudu is an ancient township of Han and as old as the Suzhou City. It has a history of more than 2,500 years and is also home to the Han's traditional handicrafts.

Yangcheng Lake hairy crabs have always been regarded as the crown of the crabs. The body of the crab does not stick to mud, its body is big and well-shaped, it has green shell with white belly, a golden claw, and yellow hair. Its meat is creamy. When the wind is blowing and the flowers are in full bloom, it is the peak season for the golden claw crab. The female crab in the lunar month of September and the male crab in October has the best gonad development. Cooked and condensed, the female crab becomes golden yellow, while the male is white-yellow. Both taste excellent and are a branded product in China.

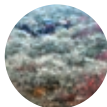
December-February Winter

② Xiangxuehai in Suzhou

Xiangxuehai is the centre of China's plum culture and also one of the country's four major spots to view plum blossoms. It is known as "Xiangxue's Plum Blossom". In February, Xiangxuehai offers a spectacular view of the plums blossoming amidst the sea of plums with fragrance. Within the scenic spot, there are the Plum Blossom Pavilion, Qianlong Royal Poetry Monument, and other attractions. In addition to viewing plum blossoms, the "Plum Blossom Festival" each year has stone carvings by the cliff, and uniquely shaped plum blossom kiosks.

JIANGSU USEFUL INFORMATION

- Visa:** Singapore citizens with ordinary passports travelling to China on business trips, visiting relatives and friends, or transiting for less than 15 days are exempted from visas. Malaysian and Indonesian citizens must apply visa for entry in advance as there is no visa-on-arrival.
- Flights:** Airlines from Singapore to Jiangsu Province include China International Airlines, China Southern Airlines, Xiamen Airlines, Shenzhen Airlines, Sichuan Airlines, Shandong Airlines, and others. The flight time ranges from five and a half hours to 10 hours. Singapore has direct flights to Nanjing and Wuxi. Transit is required for many of these cities.
- Time difference:** There is no time difference between Singapore and China.
- Weather:** Jiangsu is a coastal city with huge plains, closely-knit water networks and numerous lakes. Climate and trees in Jiangsu have both characteristics of the southern and northern regions. Climate in Jiangsu is mild with moderate rainfall. The average annual temperature in the province is 13 to 16 degrees Celsius. All seasons are suitable for travel, especially in spring and autumn.
- Voltage:** Double-hole flat-pin sockets are mostly with three-hole or double-hole specifications. Higher-grade hotels will set up a dual-use socket with 220V and 110V specifications next to the bathroom grooming table. The voltage is 220-230V.
