Jiangsu Province is bordered by Shanghai. The provincial capital is Nanjing. The 3 regions in the province of Southern Jiangsu, Central Jiangsu and Northern Jiangsu have their own characteristics in terms of cultural scenes and geographical natures. For example, Suzhou Classical Garden, cloud brocade and paper-cutting art are listed as world cultural heritages. The Grand Canal and Yangtze River that flow across the province, together with the river system of Taihu Lake constitute the natural beauty of “Enchanting Jiangsu”.

### Weather

#### Best Tourist Seasons

The average temperature in spring (April and May) and autumn (mid-September to mid-November) is 14.9°C and 16.4°C respectively.

#### Other Seasons

Summer (June to mid-September) is hotter and is more humid than Singapore and Malaysia with higher precipitation. Winter (from mid-November to March) sees average temperature of 3.0°C and visitors should stay warm.



### Payment Method

The two mobile payment apps of “WeChat Pay” and “Alipay” are more popular than cash.



### Transportation

The commonly used taxi app is “DiDi Travel”. For going around the city, visitors can travel with the city tour buses labelled “游” in Chinese (means “Tour”) covering different routes such as Tour Line No. 1 and Tour Line No. 2. The inter-city trains or the high-speed rail are convenient ways to travel to other cities or provinces. For shorter distance trips, take the domestic buses from the bus terminals.



### Voltage

A standard socket on a wall in China has two holes of the same shape and size on the upper part and earthed three flat pins on the lower part, voltage power is 220V, 50Hz. Bringing along a converter is recommended.

## CLASSIC MUST-SEE

### Qinhuai Lantern Festival

Originating from the Three Kingdoms Dongwu Period, it is now held every year during the Spring Festival for a period of 50 days. During the festival, various activities such as lantern decoration, appreciation and performances will be held on the river banks of the Qinhuai River. Visitors will usually buy a lotus lantern or a zodiac lantern to bring home with them, helping them look forward to a prosperous New Year.

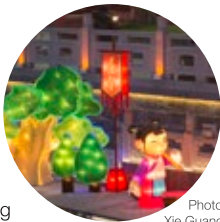

## CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

### Nanjing Cloud Brocade

This is the masterpiece of the age-old brocade technique used as a tribute to the royal family during the Yuan, Ming and Qing dynasties. Weaving the cloud brocades requires the use of a Dahualou wood weaving machine with the effort of the weaver and pattern craftsman slowly working through fine fabrics, leading to only about 5 centimetres of art work being produced a day. This is why the brocade is also called the "Inch Gold" craft.

**DAY 2 :** Wujiayui Tropical Valley → Go to Yaxi Slow City → Gaochun Ceramics → Visit the Qiqiao Ancient Village

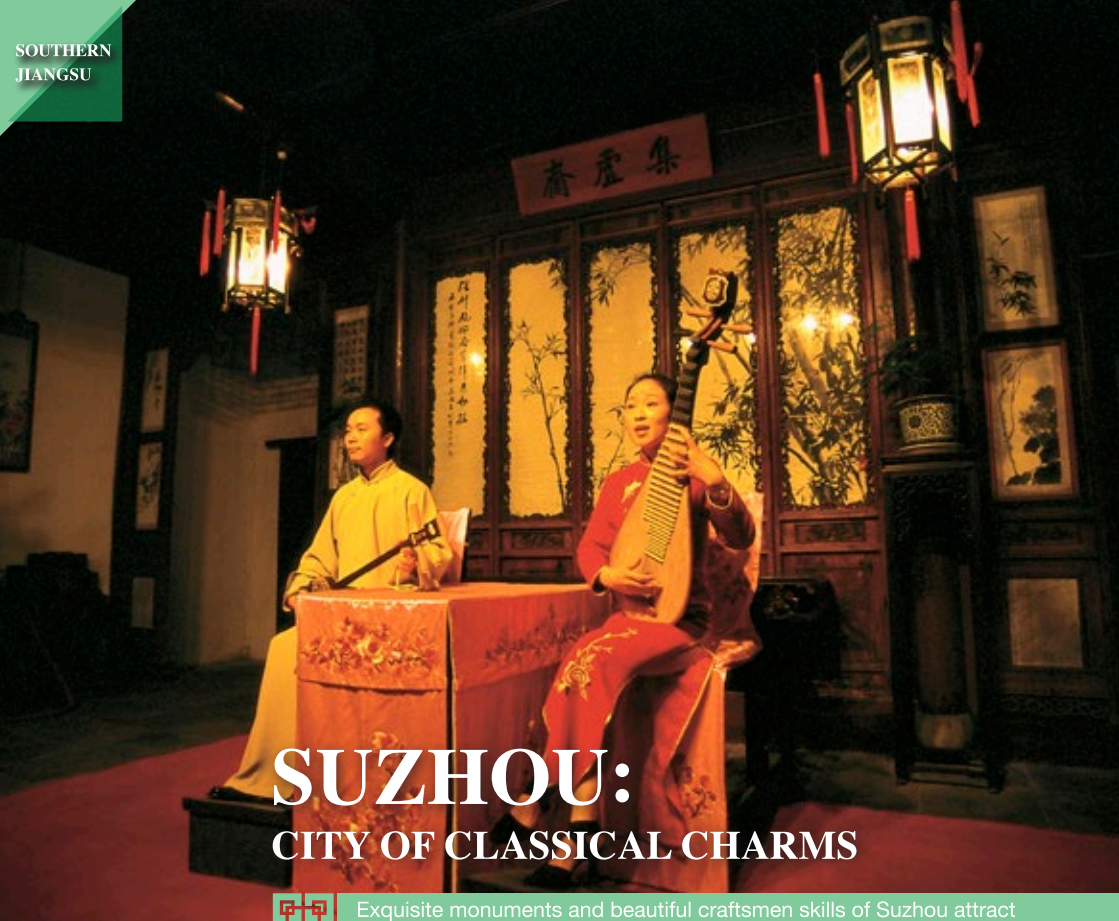

#### Shantang Street

The street takes its style from more than 1,200 years ago when poet Bai Juyi was the official of Suzhou. If you want to try local snacks, do not miss the Su style sugar pastry, jujube cake, pine nuts sweet and so on. ### TRENDY NEW SPOTS

#### Jinji Lake Scenic Zone

Located in the Suzhou Industrial Park, this is the largest inner city lake in China. Around the Ligong Dike, one can find the Harley Davidson Motorcycle Museum and the Yao Jianping Embroidery Art Museum. The Moonlight Pier was once ranked number one in the "Top Ten Most Beautiful Night Scenes in Suzhou". For those who are interested in circumnavigating the 22-kilometre lake, cycling is the perfect choice.

### CULTURAL EXPERIENCE

#### Suzhou Silk Weaving Skill

The silk technique uses a plain wood machine, a bamboo shuttle and a dial to weave the colourful silk thread into an artwork using a method of "passing through the weft", leveraging the shuttle as a pen and the silk as the paint. This work of art not only possesses a high aesthetic value, but also can be preserved for over a thousand years. Zhouzhuang is a good place to see masterpieces of this weaving technique.

### Taihu Lake Yuantouzhu Cherry Blossoms

Yuantouzhu is a popular sakura (cherry blossom) attraction. From the beginning of March each year, Winter sakura, Kawazu Sakura and Fujian Sakura take their turns to blossom and flourish. In the middle and late March, the well-known Yoshino Sakura presents its peak blossom, rendering the surrounding area of the Changchun Bridge into a sea of pink, gradually turning white only in early April.

### Nianhua Bay, Lingshan Town

### Wuxi Cuisine

The Wuxi cuisine is well-known for its emphasis on sweet flavouring. The Wuxi Xiaolongbao (soup dumpling) is a brownish red pastry with its sweet flavouring overtaking its savoury flavour, which is different from the Shanghai Xiaolongbao which looks whitish and tastes more savoury. ### City Transportation

To get to the Qingming Bridge, take Bus No. 111 to Tongyang South Road (Qingming Road) Station. Take Bus No. 2 to Huishan Ancient Town (Yinyuan Park Station) and to Xihui Park. Bus No. 1 passes by Yuantouzhu and Li Garden. Take the Tour Line No. 2 to get to the Lingshan Great Buddha Scenic Area and Nianhua Bay.

# ZHENJIANG: THREE MOUNTAINS AND “THREE ODDS”

Zhenjiang is well known for its religious mountains, myths, legends  
and historical tales.

## CLASSIC MUST-SEE

### Jinshan Mountain Scenic Area

Jinshan Mountain, Jiaoshan Mountain and Beigu Mountain are together known as the “Three Peaks of Jingkou”. The most famous site on the mountain is the Jinshan Temple, which is built on mountain terrain and blends in with its surroundings. Those who visit Jinshan are attracted by the story of “The flooding of Jinshan” in the *White Snake* legend, proving the long-lasting charm of this local folk tale.

### Baohua Mountain National Park

The mountain is a natural oxygen bar, and it is also the habitat of two rare species of Baohua magnolia and the Papilio tiger. As the “first mountain of the Vinaya school in Buddhism”, the Longchang Temple in the mountain has a history of more than 1,500 years. The Qianhua Village at the foothill is a well preserved village. One can enjoy performances at the Huashan Temple Fair during the Spring Festival.

### The Three Odds of Zhenjiang

“The vinegar never expired, the meat is not to be eaten as a dish, and the pot lid is cooked inside the pot” is a famous local jingle. “Never expired” represents the quality of aged vinegar; “Not to be eaten as a dish” means the crystal pork shoulder meat can be used as a banquet main dish or be diced to serve as breakfast; “Pot lid is cooked” means the pot covered with a lid which is used to cook the “jumping noodles”.

### City Transportation

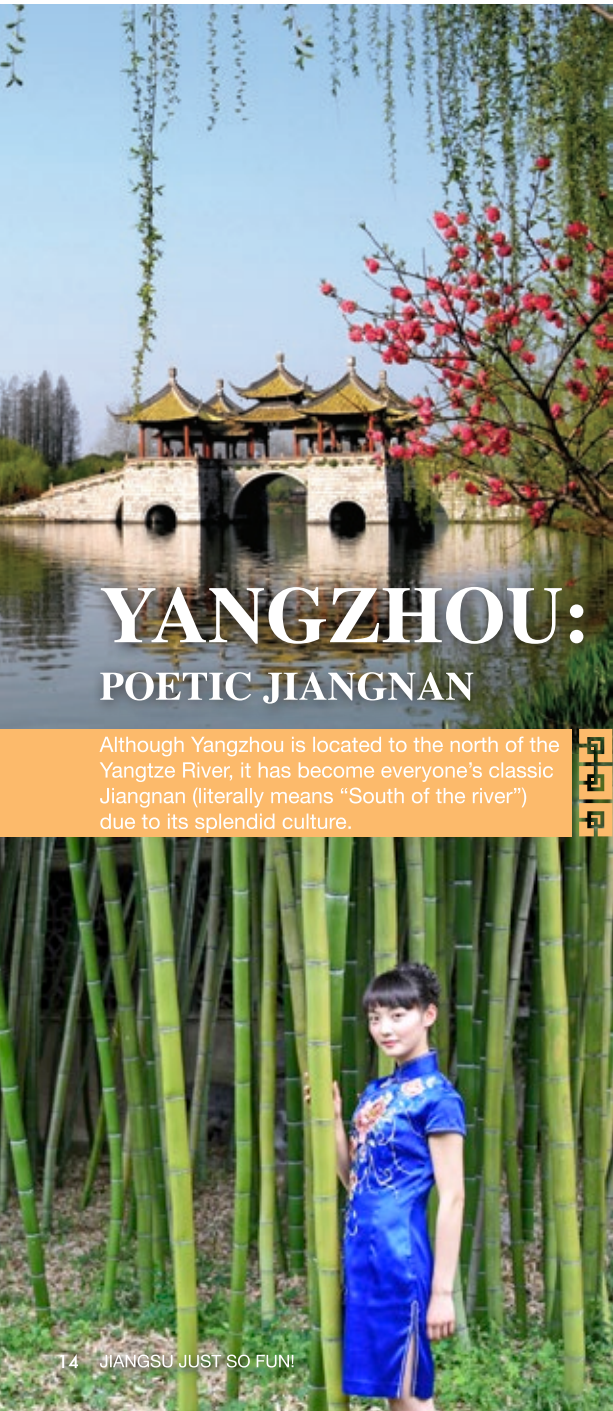

#### Slender West Lake

There is a saying of "There are 36 West Lakes in total", but the Yangzhou Slender West Lake stands out for its graceful appearance. During the spring season in Yangzhou, the shores of Slender West Lake are full of blowing willows and flower blossoms. The airy pavilions and pagodas built by the salt merchants during the Qing dynasty render a picturesque view resembling unfolding paintings.

#### Marco Polo Flower World

#### Fuchun Tea House

Founded in 1885, the 100-year-old shop is a good place to experience Yangzhou's leisure culture of "water in the skin in the morning, skin in the water in the evening". "Water in the skin" is a vivid description of the soup dumpling, and also refers to the morning tea breakfast. The "Kuilongzhu" tea goes perfectly with Fuchun's meat and bamboo shoots bun, shumai, thousand-layered oil cake and crab soup dumpling.

#### City Transportation

The "Tour Line" costs 2RMB per person. The "Tourist Bus" operates from March to November and costs 5RMB per person with unlimited rides on the same day. Both routes pass through the scenic spots such as Slender West Lake, Daming Temple, Songjiacheng, Shi Kefa Memorial Hall, Ge Garden and Dongguan Old Pier.

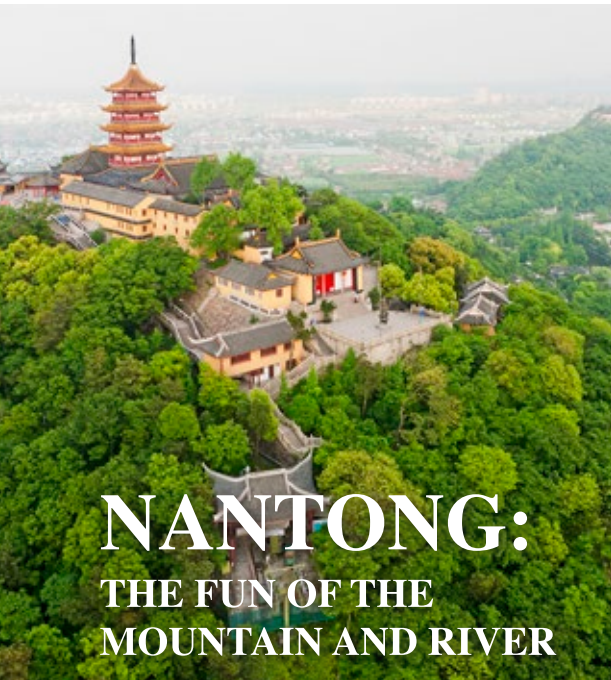

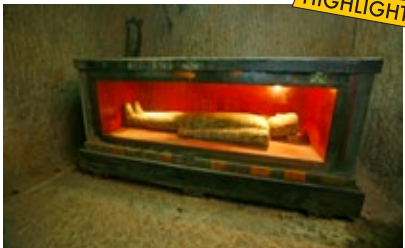

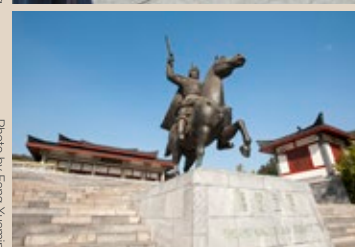
