

Introduction & Map 连云港简介&地图 Of LIANY UNG ANG

Lianyungang is a port city in northeastern Jiangsu. Huaguo Mountain, a major place featured in novel 'Journey to the West', has picturesque sceneries all year long.

Liandao Island, the largest island in Jiangsu, offers amazing sceneries of mountains, sea, beaches, strangely-shaped stones, fishing villages, and more.

Donghai county in Lianyungang is nicknamed 'the county of rock crystal'; as it contains nearly half of China's rock crystal reserve, while the Donghai hot spring is regarded as 'the best hot spring in East China'.





Seaborne Yuntai Mountain

Seaborne Yuntai Mountain was used to be an island in the sea, and was latter joint with the mainland between the 18th and 19th Century. Besides hilly topography, there are waterfall, farmyard, villages, coastal promenade and even a cargo port within this tourist hotspot, where you may behold the spectacular views of rolling greens and rippling blues.

Huaguo Mountain

Touted as the real location that the novel 'Journey to the West' was based upon as the origin place of Monkey God, Huaguo Mountain is famous within China and afar. There are several natural scenic spots that inspired the story. Within the undulating hilly terrain of Huaguo Mountain, Yunu Ridge is the highest peak throughout Jiangsu Province with a remarkably height of 624.4m above sea level.

Kongwang Mountain

This mountain is named after Confucius the philosopher who climbed the mountain to behold sea view. Here, the Buddha stone sculpture on the cliff made since the Eastern Han dynasty is the oldest Buddhist stone sculpture ever found in China.

Qinshan Island Tourist Resort

The island is connected to the mainland through a narrow stretch of natural beach dotted with colourful pebbles which were washed ashore. There is a 20m tall natural ridge protruded from sea level, namely the 'General Stone'. Take a hike to the top when it's misty in the morning and you might be lucky to witness mirage.

Liandao Seashore Tourist Resort

This tourist site features mountain, sea, forest, stone, beach and sociocultural attractions that cater for all seasons. The beachside swimming pool is the largest natural of its kind, and the best in Jiangsu Province. Also offering a myriad of seafood, it is a favourite destination among the holidaymakers from everywhere around the world.





Lianyungang Yunwu Tea

Yuntai Mountain is highly proximate to Yellow Sea, hence being granted a humid weather. The local tea trees here are mostly shrouded in misty clouds. Yunwu Tea is the native tea produced in Lianyungang, known for its lively green texture. Listed together with Nanjing Yuhua Tea and Suzhou Biluochun Tea as the three best teas from Jiangsu Province, Lianyungang Yunwu Tea's taste is remarkably irresistible.

Donghai Crystal

Donghai produces crystals in large amount and good quality. This is the largest crystal manufacturing market in China, once produced the largest crystal in the world as well as the crystal coffin for the late Chairman Mao.

Donghai Hot Spring

After sightseeing around the nature's splendours of Lianyungang, you may opt for a comfortable hot spring retreat, which is truly relaxing. The hot spring water is of fluorosilicate basis with medicinal effect, rich in calcium, sodium, potassium, zinc, fluorine and altogether 30 types of mineral.

VISA

Singaporean passport holders enjoy 15-day stay in China without visa, whereas Malaysian passport holders will have to apply for tourist visa.



Flights

Singapore/Kuala Lumpur --> Lianyungang:

There is no direct flight to Lianyungang. You will have to take flight from Singapore to Xuzhou, from which you can take a train or bus to Lianyungang.



Weather Condition

Seasons Suitable for Tourists Sightseeing:

The average temperature in spring (April to May) and autumn (mid-September to mid-November) is 14.9°C and 16.4°C respectively.

Other Seasons:

Summer (June to mid-September) more humid than Singapore and Malaysia, accompanied with raining season; Winter (mid-November to end of March) with average temperature around 3.0°C, please keep warm.

Time Difference

Singapore and Malaysia are within the same time zone (GMT+8) with China.





Voltage

Voltage power is 220V, 50Hz. Recommended to bring along plug convertor.
