


Introduction & Map of WUXI

Wuxi is known as 'the pearl of Taihu Lake'. Yuantouzhu peninsula on the northwestern shore of Taihu Lake, near Wuxi, is a popular spot for cherry blossom viewing in the spring.

The Grand Buddha at Ling Shan and the Nianhua Bay are emerging destinations for religious sightseeing.

Wuxi people are especially fond of sweetness, hence many Wuxi cuisines have a sweet taste, such as Wuxi braised pork ribs, Wuxi mini soup dumplings, and Liangxi river deep fried eel.

Lakeside Sceneries 湖畔美景

Yuantouzhu Peninsula

Located in the northwestern shore of Taihu Lake, Yuantouzhu is a tourist hotspot for cherry blossom sightseeing during the spring season. Other than appreciating the Taihu Lake sceneries, you can even take a boat ride to explore the island in the middle of the lake.

Liyuan Garden

Liyuan Garden is located by the Lihu Lake, surrounded by water. Every year from June to September is the most ideal period of time to appreciate the blooming season of lotus. Even if you miss the season, the lake view during sunset is remarkably magnificent and worth watching.

It is the first television city cum theme park built in China, which incorporated with tourism industry. Located at the edge of Taihu Lake, it was where the well-acclaimed television dramas 'Romance of Three Kingdoms' and 'Water Margin' filmed and produced.

Buddhist Culture 佛教文化

Nianhua Bay Lakeside Town

There are a variety of oriental landscaped sceneries here, including creeks, bridges, and gazebos, ideal for tea tasting and sightseeing. Here, you can pay a visit to various cultural galleries and handicrafts souvenir shops. Just sit down for a short break to quench thirst and refresh. Nianhua Bay is offering exceptional Zen-themed living experiences such as flower arrangement, tea tasting, Buddhist scripture learning, etc.

Lingshan Grand Buddha

The tallest bronze statue of Buddha is rising at 88m, sculpted with a sense of serenity. There is another gigantic sculpture depicting the hand of Buddha, exclusively built for prayers. Here, a grand outdoor performance entitled 'The Blessing of Lingshan' is thoughtfully curated near Brahma Palace, which is the Buddhism equivalent of cultural art museum.

Huishan Old Town

Huishan Old Town is nestled amidst a natural environment. All ancient buildings are well-kept. You get to appreciate beautiful sceneries layered by red maples and green ginkgo trees. The spring water from Huishan was rated by an ancient tea master Lu Yu as the 'Second Best Spring Water Under Heaven', cooling with a sweet taste. Inside the Ceramic Puppet Museum of China, there are a number of miniatures in exhibition. You will also get to taste silver lining noodles, mini soup dumplings and bean curd desserts.

Qingming Bridge Old Canal

Qingming Bridge is a 400-year-old single-hole stone arch bridge that crossing canal within the water town. The waterfront street namely Nanchang Street was famous for its handicrafts and trading businesses. Now the street is filled with a vast selection of bars for food and beverage. If you pay a visit at night, you will be amazed by the nostalgic town, ancient bridge and old boats well-lit by red lanterns in an orient setting.

Food & Beverage 饮食文化

Wuxi cuisine is generally very sweet, popular with Wuxi braised pork ribs and Wuxi mini soup dumplings, to name a few. Wuxi pork ribs are red in colour, savoury and sweet, whereas Wuxi mini soup dumplings are filled with tasty soup that is red in colour, sweet and a little salty, unlike the mini soup dumplings in Shanghai, which are salty in general. There is a very unique kind of local cuisine which is available on boat restaurants by steaming and sautéing, using native freshwater ingredients such as white fish, silver fish and white prawns.

VISA

Singaporean passport holders enjoy 15-day stay in China without visa, whereas Malaysian passport holders will have to apply for tourist visa.

Flights

Singapore ---> Wuxi:

You can take Scoot direct flight from Singapore to Sunan Shuofang International Airport. The flight journey usually takes 5 hours 35 minutes.



Kuala Lumpur ---> Wuxi:

There is no direct flight to Wuxi. You will have to take flight to Shanghai or Hangzhou, from which you can take a train to Wuxi.



Voltage

Voltage power is 220V, 50Hz. Recommended to bring along plug convertor.

Weather Condition

Seasons Suitable for Tourists Sightseeing:

The average temperature in spring (April to May) and autumn (mid-September to mid-November) is 14.9°C and 16.4°C respectively.

Other Seasons:

Summer (June to mid-September) more humid than Singapore and Malaysia, accompanied with raining season; Winter (mid-November to end of March) with average temperature around 3.0°C, please keep warm.

Time Difference

Singapore and Malaysia are within the same time zone (GMT+8) with China.
