

徐州简介&地图 of XUZHOU

Xuzhou city borders Shandong Province to the north. The city in northwestern Jiangsu boasts a rich historical heritage, such as three important ancient relics from the Han dynasty - Han tombs, Han terracotta warriors and horses, and Han portrait stone.

In Xuzhou, there are many historic sites related to Su Dongpo, a poet widely regarded as one of the most accomplished figures in classical Chinese literature, including the Huanglou, Swallow Tower and Crane-releasing Pavilion. Xuzhou is also where a prominent dish called Dongpo pork, which is named in the poet's honor, first appeared.

Jiawang Dugongshan Skiing Paradise is the biggest comprehensive ski area in Jiangsu Province.



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Cultural History 历史文化

Xuzhou Han Cultural Scenic Area

The site displays three iconic cultural heritage inherited from the Han dynasty, including Han tomb, Han terracotta warriors and horses, and Han portrait stone. It is one of the largest cultural preservation base in China for Han culture.

Horse-Traning Terrace of Xiang Yu

This terrace is one of the most historic sites in Xuzhou, built by Xiang Yu the hegemon-king of Western Chu used to be an equestrian park, also used for militant practice, military parade and etc.




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Yaowan Ancient Town

Rich in history over the millennium, Yaowan used to be a major settlement along the Grand Canal, and still preserving old fortress, city gate and various other strongholds. There are many pawn shops, taverns and sauce manufacturing workshops remain thriving till dates.

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Nature amid City 城市山水

■ Yunlong Lake

A sister lake to West Lake, Hangzhou, Yunlong Lake is famous for its natural settings of Yunlong Mountain landscape. Measuring at a perimeter of 12km, the vast lake is one of the most breathtaking city lakes in China, mesmerising with different views every season. The main tourist hotspots here include a lake garden, a lake pavilion, Yunlong Water World Marina Promenade, and a lakefront sunshine beach.

■ Yunlong Mountain

142m above sea level, this mountainous range is divided into nine sections, and you're given an opportunity to behold the breathtaking view of the city panorama from the viewing deck perched on the 3rd section. There are numerous cultural heritage sites along the hiking path, where crisp fresh air is refreshing. The magnificently misty sceneries here is highly sought-after by nature's lovers including prominent persons such as Liu Bang, Su Dongpo, Qianlong Emperor, Mao Zedong, Chiang Kai-shek to name among the hikers.

■ Hubu Hill Pedestrian Streets

Built on ascending terrain, these old houses are complete with a traditional courtyard surrounded by stretch of rooms made of rock bricks and roof coverings. These mansions belong to five big families namely Yu, Zhai and so on, now open for public visit after a meticulous restoration to display the real architectural masterpieces from the Ming and Qing dynasties.

■ Huilongwo Cultural Streets

These streets were built since the Qing dynasty, and now transformed into an integrated tourist street with a restful sense of leisure. Since local brands and contemporary shops set their feet here, now the street has become a hangout hotspot for youngsters to check in. The local museum also recorded the changes of Xuzhou city in history.

■ Abandoned Yellow River Sightseeing Promenade

Before the Yellow River was rerouted in year 1855, it traversed Xuzhou for more than 700 years. Now the old river bank here is refurbished into a 6.3km long of memory lane where tourists can take a stroll enriched by culture and relive the charming past.

Food & Beverage 饮食文化

Xuzhou has been the origin place of Chinese culinary, indeed the hometown of Master Chef Pengzu since 4,000 years ago. In the heydays, even scholars from Tang and Song dynasties invented a number of famous dishes here in Xuzhou. The culinary style in Xuzhou is significantly different from other places, with a unique spicy flavour, can be either savoury yet not salty, light but not tasteless, thick but not over creamy. Other than that, the local citizens also crave for the street food here.

Flights

Singapore ---> Xuzhou:

You can take Jetstar direct flight from Singapore to Xuzhou Guanyin International Airport. The flight journey usually takes 5 hours 20 minutes.



Kuala Lumpur ---> Xuzhou:

There is no direct flight to Xuzhou. You will have to transit at Singapore Changi International Airport.

Weather Condition

Seasons Suitable for Tourists Sightseeing:

The average temperature in spring (April to May) and autumn (mid-September to mid-November) is 14.9°C and 16.4°C respectively.

Other Seasons:

Summer (June to mid-September) more humid than Singapore and Malaysia, accompanied with raining season; Winter (mid-November to end of March) with average temperature around 3.0°C, please keep warm.

Time Difference

Singapore and Malaysia are within the same time zone (GMT+8) with China.
